## Directions

### By car


Exit M4 at junction 19 marked for the M32. Follow the M32 into Bristol. At St. James Barton roundabout take the second exit onto B4051/Marlborough Street. Continue onto A4018/Queen's Rd and go round Triangle one-way system. Heading north, turn left into Park Place and then continue straight on along Meridian Place and York Place to Clifton Road, where you find Goldney Hall. Please note that there is no car parking available at Goldney; there is limited on-street parking in the vicinity, and the nearest off-street parking is in Berkeley Place.

### By train

Temple Meads is the closest railway station, from which you can take a taxi or bus. The number 8 bus service stops in Victoria Square and Clifton village, both a 5min walk from the hall.

### By air

Bristol International Airport is only 13 kilometres to the south of the city. From there you can (a) take a taxi, (b) take the Bristol flyer bus service airport to the city centre bus station and then take a taxi, or (c) take the Bristol flyer to the railway station and then take the number 8 bus (see above).
